

## NASA exhibit touched down at Owensville library

An exhibit NASA: Spirit of Discovery was stationed near the Owensville library last week. A 38-foot long mobile teaching and learning center called the Southeast Explorer contained the mobile exhibit and stopped for the morning of May 21 to allow local residents (as shown in photo above) the chance to tour the exhibit. The exhibits and activities are geared for children in grades 3 to 6, but even adults were fascinated by the information presented in the mobile center. Students were bussed to the exhibit from their schools and toured the local library as they waited for their turns with the exhibits. 236 kids and 30 adults made their way through the NASA-themed bus.
