Borrowing Titles from Overdrive on Your Kindle Fire

Step 1: Download the Overdrive App

- 1. Tap Amazon Appstore icon.
- 2. Search for Overdrive.
- 3. Tap "Download."

Step 2: Set Up Your Overdrive Account

- 1. Tap the Overdrive icon.
- 2. Tap "Sign Up."
- 3. Tap "Sign up using your library card."
- 4. Enter Scenic Regional Library and tap "Go."
- 5. Tap "Scenic Regional Library HQ."
- 6. Enter your library card number.
- 7. Tap "Sign In."

Step 3: Borrowing a Title

- 1. Tap the menu button.
- 2. Tap "Bookshelf."
- 3. Tap "Add a Title."
- 4. Find a title you want to borrow.
- 5. Tap "Borrow."
- 6. If prompted, enter your library card number and tap "Sign In."

Step 4: Reading / Listening to a Title

Please note that you will need your Amazon account log in information to get download your library book to your device. Also, the title will download to your device so that you can read it or listen to it offline. You will need an active internet connection while it is downloading.

- 1. Tap the loans button. (3 books)
- 2. Tap "Choose a Format."
- 3. Tap "Kindle Book."
- 4. Tap "Get Kindle Book."
- 5. Scroll to the right and tap "Get Library Book."
- 6. Enter your Amazon account information and tap "Sign in."
- 7. Choose your device in the "Deliver to" field.
- 8. Tap "Continue."
- 9. Go back to your Fire's home page and tap on the book cover.

Step 5: Returning a Title Early

- 1. Open the Silk browser and go to Amazon.com.
- 2. Log into your Amazon account.
- 3. Tap on "Accounts and Lists."
- 4. Tap "Manage Your Content and Devices."
- 5. Tap the "Your Content" tab.

- 6. Tap the three-dot menu button to the left of the book you want to return.
- 7. Tap "Return this book."
- 8. Tap "Yes."
