Library Purchases Property for New Pacific Branch

On December 8, the library purchased a 1.5 acre lot on the corner of Rose Lane and Lamar Parkway in Pacific. The property will be the site for a new Pacific branch. The library plans to build an approximately 10,000 square foot facility on the property within the next three years. The current library in Pacific is 4,000 square feet.






A Google Earth image of the future Pacific branch site on the corner of Rose Lane and Lamar Parkway. The future site is in the middle of the current new development happening in Pacific.

New Award Will Recognize Missouri Authors

The Missouri Library Association has created a new award. The Missouri Author Awards recognize a fiction and a non-fiction title by a Missouri author published during the three calendar years prior to the year the award is presented. A Missouri author is defined as someone who was born in Missouri or has lived in Missouri for at least



five years. The honoree must be living. Anyone may nominate an author for one of these awards. Nominations do not need to come from library staff though the nomination form gives that impression. 


Gasconade, and Warren Counties; published in the library's newsletter; and displayed on the branch Facebook pages. In addition, the winners will receive new art supplies.




Pacific Branch Named Business of the Month
