Adult Programs at Library in March

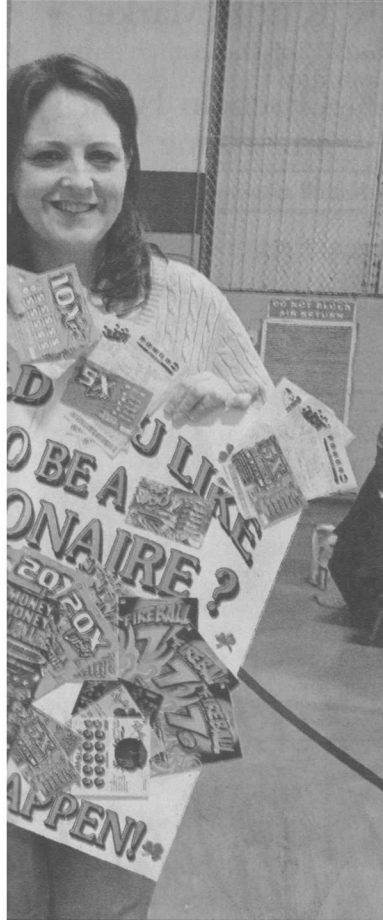
