## Library launches online meeting room reservation system

ing room at any Scenic Regional Library branch using a new online system called Evanced.

If you would like to reserve a meeting room at a Scenic Regional Library branch, visit the library's website at www. scenicregional.org, click on the "Meeting Room" link on the menu, and begin the reservation process. You will need to create an account the first time.

With the exception of the Hermann branch, all branches have meeting rooms. While the primary purpose of the

programming spaces for the library, they can also be reserved by outside groups, such as businesses, nonprofit organizations, community groups, and individuals. Use of the library meeting rooms is free.

The biggest rules regarding the meeting rooms are that groups can't charge admission or an entry fee to their meetings and they can't be selling any products or services. The rooms also can't be used for personal use or social events, such as weddings, funerals, birthday parties, or reunions.

Organizations are allowed meeting.

Groups can reserve a meet- meeting rooms is to provide to have meals catered for their meetings in the library's meeting rooms, such as for a Rotary or Chamber luncheon.

Meeting rooms are available after Library hours, including Sundays, but the representative of the group making the reservation must pick up a key at the branch prior to the meeting.

As with most meeting spaces, groups are responsible for setting up tables and chairs. They are also responsible for disposing of trash, vacuuming and, if needed, wiping down tables and counters after their
