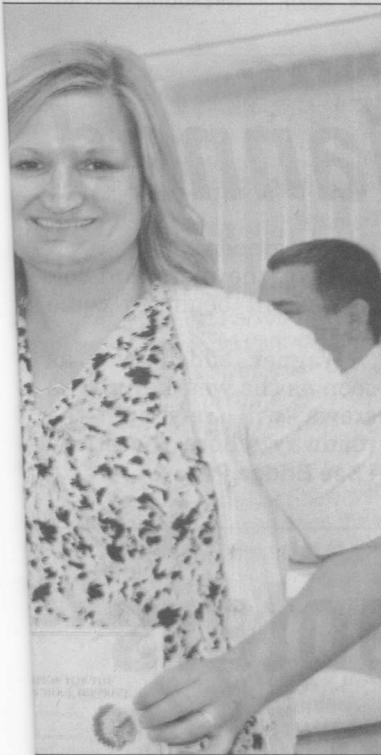


nd "In their balance routine, Destiny bends her body into a deep arch position, and Katie soars over Destiny doing a layout back flip," Borcharding explained.
