American Cancer Society. Funds go toward programs that contribute to cancer's prevention, treatment or cure.

Relay For Life of Warren County will be held from 4-10 p.m. in the field house at Black Hawk Middle School, 302 Kuhl Ave., Warrenton. With forecasts calling for rain, the event was moved indoors.

Bohn hopes the entire community will help pay tribute to Jean and Al. She said the microphone will be open to anyone who wants, or needs, to talk about Jean.

Organizers had already been asking the community to send in or prepare oral testimonials about Jean, Al, and the support group.

"We'd love to have as many people at the event as possible for pictures and personalized letters to be made," Bohn had said.

The Relay For Life opening ceremony starts at 6 p.m. and will include tributes. The annual survivor lap will follow. The luminaria ceremony, which allows guests to remember loved ones who lost their battle with cancer, will begin at 8:30 p.m.

Bohn said Jean will be included in the luminaria ceremony.

Jean was born May 5, 1935, in Eolia, Mo. She and Al married Aug. 2, 1953, at Whiteside Baptist Church in Whiteside, Mo. They had five children and 12 grandchildren.

Jean was a homemaker and volunteer. She participated in church missions with Fellowship Baptist Church in Warrenton. In addition to the American Cancer Society and Relay For Life, she volunteered with Look Good — Feel

Bohn said she will be providing Al with copies of tributes made to Jean at the Relay For Life event.

Services for Jean will be held at Martin Funeral Home the following day. A Celebration of Life will be held from 10 a.m. to noon Saturday, June 8, at Fellowship Baptist Church, 1015 South State Highway 47,
