How to enter

To submit an entry, please bring a copy of your letter to the nearest Scenic Regional Branch. Please include your name and your branch of Scenic Regional.

Rules

When submitting a letter, you agree to abide by the following rules:

- Contestant must be 18 years or older in age
- Letter must be one page, front only
- Participants must live in Franklin, Gasconade, or Warren counties (or the portion of Sullivan in Crawford County)

- One original entry per participant
 - Works previously published will not be accepted as a submission
- Submissions will not be returned to owner
- Deadline for entries is end of business on August 2nd, 2021

Scenic Regional Library reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is deemed inappropriate, or does not conform to the rules stated above.

Criteria

The following criteria will be used to determine the winner of the time capsule contest:

- Rules stated above were followed
- Submission is legible
 - Both handwritten and typed letters will be accepted
- Letter speaks to the future, and the library's impact on the patron and our community.

The judgement made is final, and the winning entry will be submitted to be sealed in the Missouri Bicentennial Time Capsule. The time capsule will later be re-opened and shared with the public on August 10th, 2046.
