EXHIBITION SPACE & DATES

The Gallery is located at Scenic Regional Library's Hermann Branch, 123-A Bavarian Hills Plaza in Hermann, Missouri. The exhibit will be from Friday, February 3, 2023 to Saturday, April 22, 2023. There will be an opening reception on Friday, February 3, from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. The reception is free and open to the public.

ELIGIBILITY

The Gallery's exhibit is open to regional artists, 18 years and older, and will be curated by a committee of professional artists from the Hermann area. The Gallery committee reserves the right to deny exhibit of any work failing to meet guidelines.

SPECIFICATIONS

Artists are limited to submit five (5) original pieces of artwork each for consideration. A high-resolution image of each entry in JPEG format must be emailed to Gallery Manager Sheri Hausman at gallery@scenicregional.org. Each work must be sent in a separate email. The images must be high resolution, 300dpi, 8-1/2" x 11", and minimum 800 pixels. **The body of the email must contain the artist's full name, title of the work, sale price, medium, dimensions of the work, and an artist biography. The artist biography is limited to 300 words. The images cannot be blurry or have a glare.**

ENTRY FEE

The Gallery does not have an entry fee.

DEADLINE

The deadline to submit works for this exhibit is December 31.

SALES & INSURANCE

Artwork is insured at 50% of retail value during the exhibit. The artist is responsible for the work during transit to / from the exhibit. All sales are through Scenic Regional Library with 35% of the sale price going to the Library and 65% to the artist. The library can accept payment in the form of cash, check, and debit / credit card.
