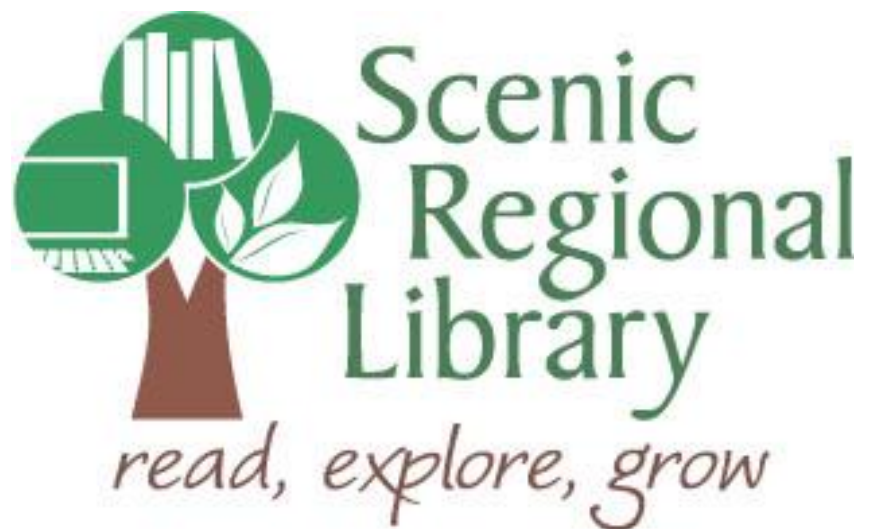

## **Craft & Hobby's Offerings to Patrons**

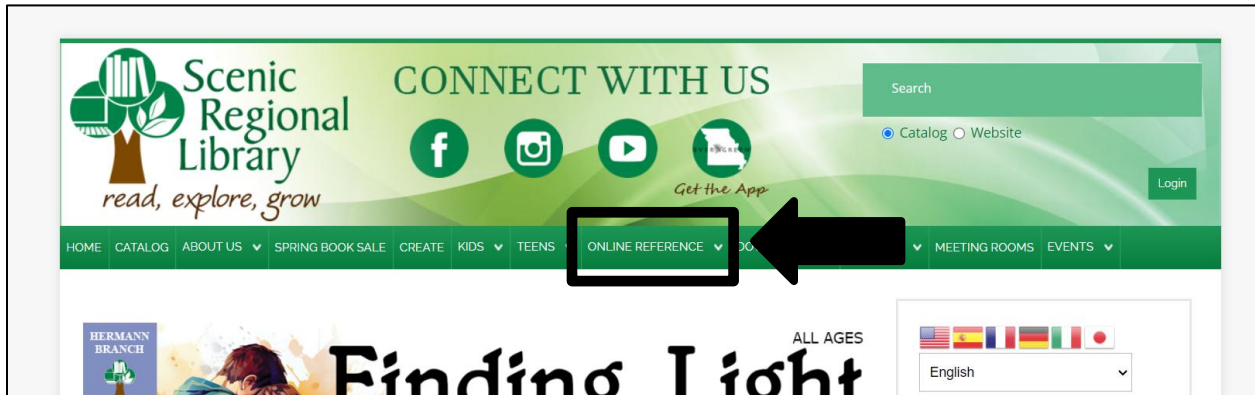
Any Scenic Regional Library patrons with accounts in good standing can access Craft & Hobby. Patrons can stream as many videos as they want.

## Accessing Craft & Hobby

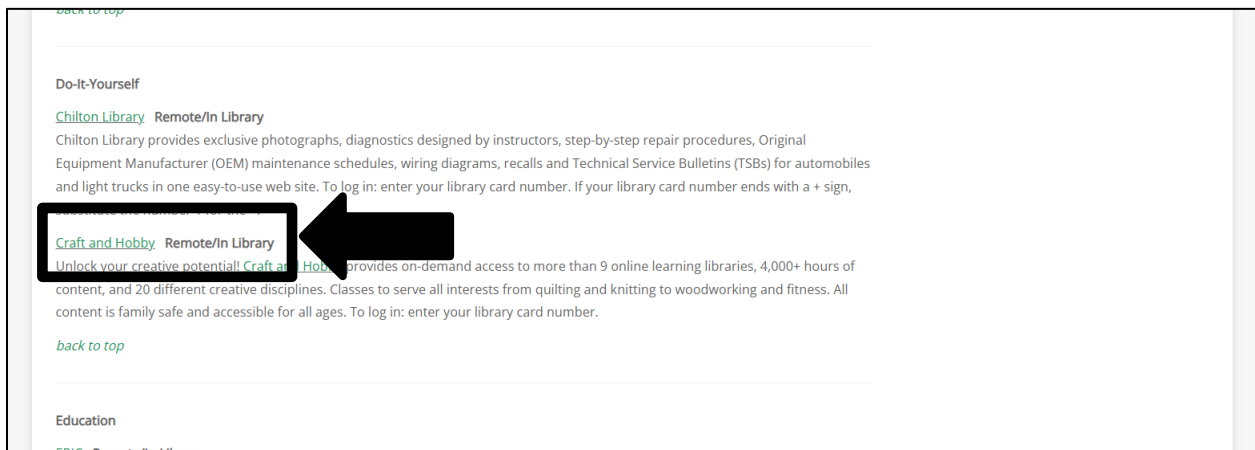
Craft & Hobby can be accessed in the library and remotely.

Follow these steps to access Craft & Hobby.

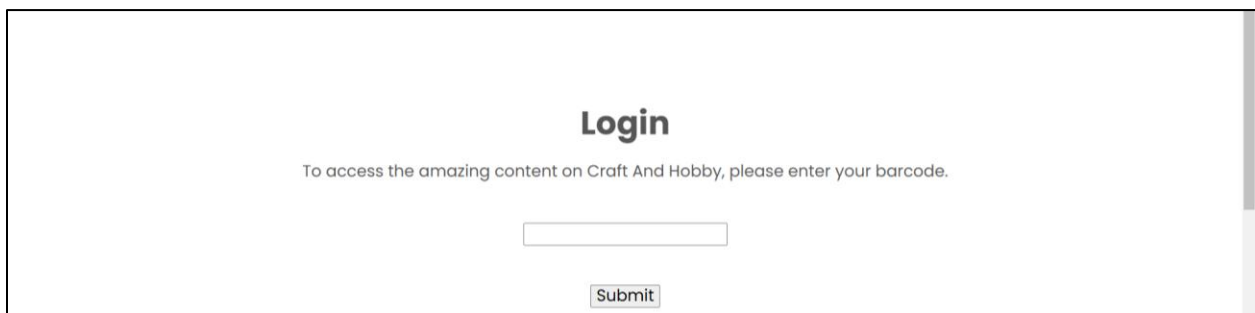
1. Go to [www.scenicregional.org](http://www.scenicregional.org).
2. Click "Online Reference."



3. Scroll down to the Do-It-Yourself section and click "Craft & Hobby."



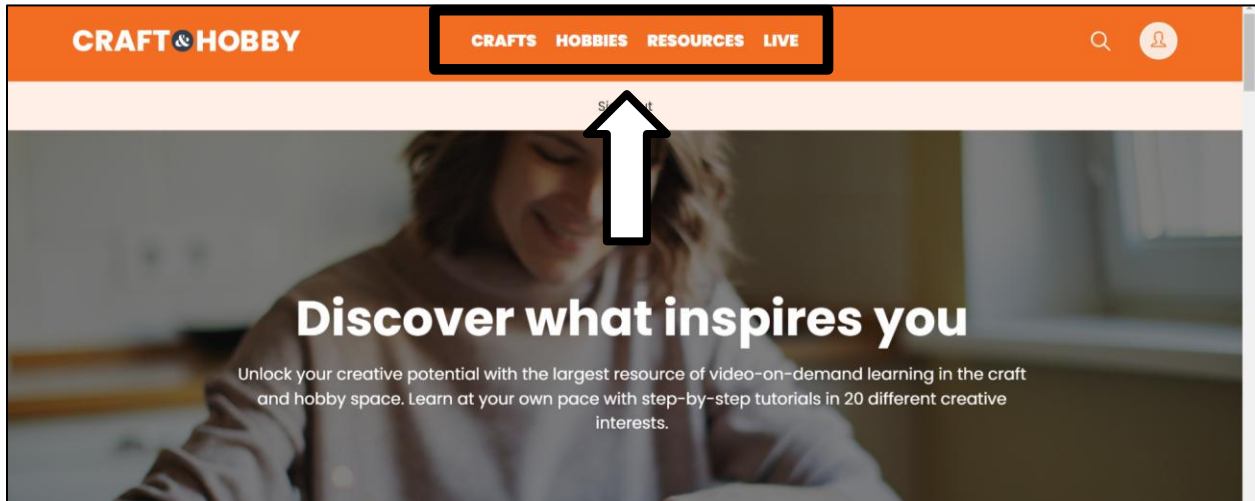
4. Enter your library card number and click "Submit." Note that if you are accessing Craft & Hobby from home, you may also have to enter your institution, which is Scenic Regional Library.



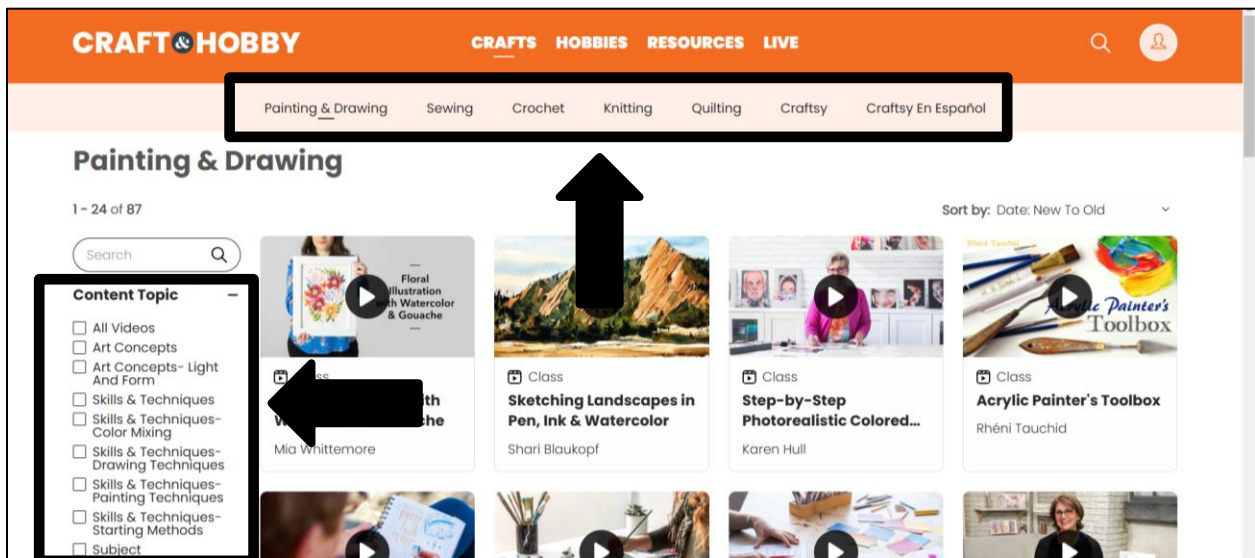
## Craft & Hobby Site Tour

Main Menu – This area contains links taking users to all the major areas of the site. Patrons will use the “Crafts” and “Hobbies” links most often.




Once you click on either “Crafts” or “Hobbies,” you will find a page with a menu of sub-categories and content topic filters to assist them in finding the perfect video.




