# Regional Library's Book Circulation Totals 264,354

Scenic Regional Library's statistics for the year 1968 show that 264,354 books were checked out. This means that the 51,572 people in the regional library district read an average of more than five books each. In addition to books, patrons used 14,713 magazines, phonograph records and framed pictures, making a total circulation of 279,067 for the year. New families who registered to use the library totaled 950.

Community groups and schools borrowed 1,609 filmstrips and 520 educational films.

Circulation from each of the li-

brary's service outlets was as follows: New Haven, 10,604; Owenville, 18,888; Pacific, 26,171; St. Clair, 25,702; and Warrenton, 28,417. Bookmobile circulation totaled 120,076. Patrons who were unable to use Scenic Regional Library, by going to a bookmobile stop or a branch, were sent books by mail.
