

Newsletter Changes Beginning November 1

Subscribers to Scenic Regional Library's newsletters will notice some changes in the upcoming months. Beginning November 1, subscribers can now expect the library's newsletter to be sent on the first of the month.

Additionally, the Event Newsletter will transition to a bi-monthly format, with issues sent mid-month in January, March, May, July, and November. The entire Event Newsletter will be emailed to subscribers. Events will now be separated by region, to allow patrons the opportunity to see what is happening at nearby branches, along with events at their home branch. Within each region, the programs will be in date order and separated by the intended audience. The first Event Newsletter in this format will be sent out in November and will display all events happening in December and January.

With this change, event bookmarks will no longer be handed out at the front desk, and will be replaced with each branch's section of the Event News. This will enable patrons to view full descriptions of the programs taking place at their home and nearby branches.


Library Foundation Trivia this Saturday



Library Provides Drop Off Locations for Warners' Warm-Up Coat Drive



The library's Franklin County branches will serve as drop-off locations for this year's annual Warners' Warm-Up Coat Drive. The organization is requesting donations of new or gently used coats of all sizes—for men, women, and especially children.

This year's two-week collection period will begin on October 20 and continue until November 2.

Former St. Louis Rams quarterback Kurt Warner and his wife Brenda launched the coat drive in 2001 as a one-day drive before a Rams game. It has evolved into a two-week St. Louis metropolitan area-wide effort with hundreds of drop-off locations on both sides of the river. The Warners' Warm-up Coat Drive collects over 15,000 coats each year.

The Union branch had a wonderful program with the "Fiddle and Friends" band.




Owensville had an amazing turnout for their Halloween Tie-Dye program. Young patrons had the opportunity to tie dye a spooky shirt!


