To celebrate Missouri’s Bicentennial, Scenic Regional Library is compiling photographs of our beautiful state to create a slideshow presentation to share with our library patrons on our website, in our branches, as well as on our social media platforms. We will also be taking the top 25+ submissions and creating a wall collage in the shape of Missouri to display at our various branches throughout the year. Participation is open to professional, amateur and photography hobbyists of all ages.

Note this is a community project, not a contest. No prizes will be awarded.

How to enter:

To submit an entry, please email the photograph to joermann@scenicregional.org.

Include a brief description with name, age (if a minor), city of entrant, photo location, and year taken. If you cannot email your entry, please bring your photo into any Scenic Regional branch and they will be able to email your image.

By submitting a photo, you are agreeing to the following rules:

Rules:

- Image must have been taken within the past 2 years.
- Participants must live in Franklin, Gasconade, or Warren counties (or the portion of Sullivan in Crawford County).
- For a photo in which a person is recognizable, you must be prepared to provide a model release from the subject or, in the case of a minor, the subject’s parent or

guardian, to Scenic Regional Library upon entry submission. A release can be found [here](#).

- The image must be the original work of the person submitting it. Image must be in its original state and other than cropping and adjusting color, cannot be altered in any way. No filters, added text, photoshopping, watermarks, logos, etc.
- Maximum of 2 entries per participant.
- Deadline for entries is Friday, July 16, 2021 at 5PM. Late entries will not be accepted.

Entries will not be accepted unless submitted via the official project channel. (Emailing joermann@scenicregional.org). Entries not submitted through the proper channel will be deleted. If you cannot email your entry, please bring your photo into any Scenic Regional branch and they will be able to email your image.

Entrants agree that any images submitted can be printed and used by Scenic Regional Library for advertising purposes. Images may also be cropped to fit into the final collage. Every effort will be made to credit the image(s) to the entrant when used in the final collage, slide show, on social media, library newsletter, and/or website.

Works that are identical or very similar to other's works will be culled and a limited number will be chosen (such as several entries of photos of the Arch or fishing photos, etc.).

Scenic Regional Library reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is deemed inappropriate for a library setting, is of poor image quality or does not conform to stated project rules.
