Staff will also have heightened cleaning procedures, frequently wiping down door handles, keyboards, restroom sink handles, coffee machines, and service desk counters with disinfectant spray or wipes.

The library will continue to offer curbside service once it reopens for patrons who are still uncomfortable entering the buildings due to coronavirus, or those who want to utilize the service for any other reason.

Patrons will be able to call or email their local branch whenever the library is open and have items pulled from the shelves or placed on hold, and then pick them up. Staff will bring the items to the patron's vehicle.

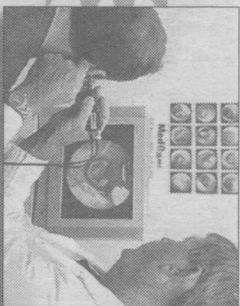
Hours for curbside service pick-up after June 1 will be Mondays, 9 a.m. to noon; Tuesdays, 4 to 7 p.m.; and Fridays, 2 to 5 p.m.

On May 18, the library began "contactless" curbside service as phase one of its reopening plan. Patrons were able to call their local branch and have items pulled from the shelves or holds placed, and then schedule a time to pick up the items from a table outside the branch.

The service was available four hours each day. On the first day of curbside service, the library served 240 patrons systemwide. In the first week, branches checked out 2,328 items through curbside service.
