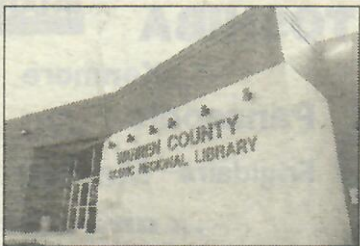

Library

Warren County is part of the Scenic Regional Library System, which also serves neighboring Franklin and Gasconade counties.

The 9,000-square-foot facility, which was built in June 2001, provides a variety of materials, including books, large print materials, books on cassette, magazines, newspapers and videos. Genealogical materials include census records for Warren County and local newspapers on microfilm.

The library has an accessible collection of books, eight computer stations, a spacious reference area where students can work on projects or adults can do genealogy

searches.

Census records from other parts of the United States as well as newspapers from other Missouri communities may be borrowed through interlibrary loan.

The facility also includes a meet-

ing room, where the library holds reading-related programs and where community organizations hold meetings. The meeting room has a separate entrance than the library, and therefore can be used even when the library is closed.

To register for a library card, residents need a driver's license or other photo identification bearing their current address.

The Warrenton library, located at 912 South Highway 47 just south of downtown Warrenton, is open six days a week. For more information, call (636) 456-3321.
