President Harry Truman's grandson coming to Union

Clifton Truman Daniel, President Harry S. Truman's grandson, will perform the one-man show "Give 'Em Hell, Harry!" at East Central College this Friday.

The Washington Public Library and Scenic Regional Library are collaborating as part of the This Community Reads program to bring this free event to the area. The play starts at 7 p.m. and will be at the ECC Anglin Performing Arts Center, 1964 Prairie Dell Road in Union.

"Give 'Em Hell, Harry!" was written by Samuel Gallu and pre-miered at Ford's Theatre in 1975. Later that same year, one of the performances was recorded and made into a film. The play portrays President Truman's life and presidency in a humorous way. The title was based on an audience member's comment when Truman was making a speech during the 1948 presidential election campaign.

Throughout years, the play has been resurrected numerous times, and in 2017, Daniel took over the role of Truman in the play's revival. This marked the first time in histoonstage performance.
