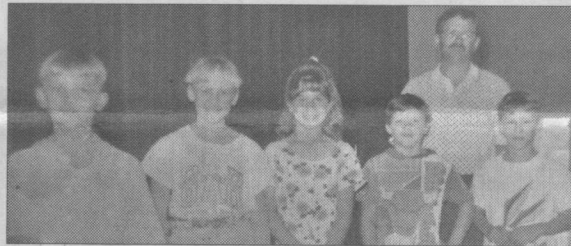
### RR Donnelly receives flag from 113.

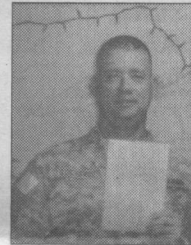
