St. Clair City Administrator
 Travis Dierker said the city be-

 traffic study with the Missouri
 Department of Transportation
 (MoDOT) during the Bardot
 Street project in late 2018.

MoDOT conducted the
 study at no cost to the city
 during the fall of 2019 and
 concluded there was a need to
 have the light cycle full time.
